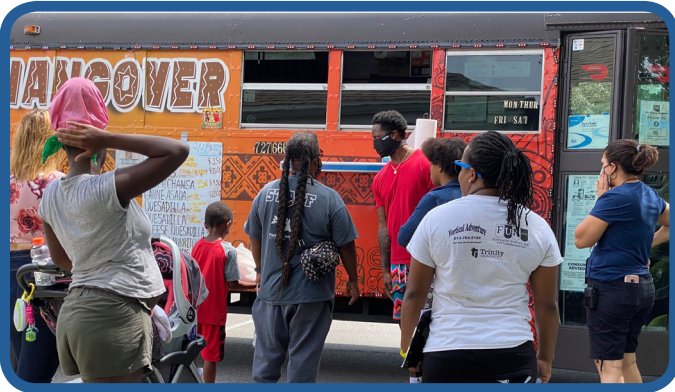

A Second Chance



Supporting caregivers so they can heal the traumatized child is the essence of the Children's Home Network's Kinship and Emotional Support Programs in Central Florida. Our role is not to foster dependency or to burden caregivers with unnecessary frustration, but to draw their strength out of chaos and guide them to a sense of family and autonomy that will endure.

It is hard to imagine what it is like for a 4-year-old to witness the murder of her mother, but that is Isabella's story. This horrific event was the tragic ending to the difficult relationship between her mother and her mother's boyfriend. Domestic violence continues to be a primary reason for child protective services and sadly for Isabella, it took her mother's life.

Recognizing that families are the greatest source of healing for children like Isabella, her child protection worker located Aunt Janet, who was able and more than willing to take her niece into her home. Relative caregivers are confronted by these emotional and challenging decisions daily, without warning, and often at all hours of the day or night. Not only was Janet grappling with the death of her sister, she was now suddenly the parent of a 4-year-old. She was grieving but committed, and needed CHN's support as she was also now immersed in the complex and confusing world of child protective services and

the court system. For this reason, the family was referred to CHN's Emotional Support Program, and services were immediately offered.

From the time Isabella was placed into her care, the main goal was to adopt her, securing her future and establishing Janet as her legal mother. But the journey presented many challenges and being a part of CHN Caregiver Emotional Support Services, according to Janet, was a "godsend." In addition to navigating the system, Janet was very concerned about the trauma that her niece experienced and was uncertain what support she needed or how to access it. CHN's Emotional Support specialist quickly engaged with and supported Janet throughout the process, ensuring she understood what was happening and why, and helped prepare her to succeed in accomplishing the goal of adoption. With this level of support, Janet's anxiety and fears subsided and her strength, faith, and unwavering commitment to her niece emerged. As a result, she was able to apply for benefits for Isabella, access grief therapy for both herself and her niece, enroll Isabella in Pre-K and attend Support Groups with other families who were caring for a relative's child. Other supports was tangible, as becoming the parent to a 4-year-old was not something Janet had anticipated; therefore, securing a bed, car seat, and other items for Isabella were priorities that her CHN Emotional Support specialist was able to quickly resolve.

Isabella and her mother (aunt) Janet are fully engaged in the support services that CHN linked them with and they continue on their healing journey. The adoption was recently finalized and because the family received the support and direction needed in the early stages of their case, they are able to continue without the involvement of child protective services or Emotional Support Services. Janet knows that she can contact CHN at any time should the need arise, but she is confident and independent as families should be. Janet's deceased sister can safely be at peace to know her sister adopted her daughter Isabella and that family is restored for her little girl.

Children's Home Network Grant Spotlight

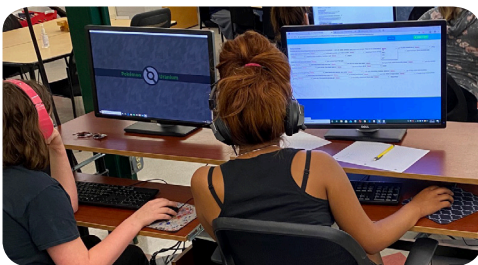

COVID-19 made 2020 a challenging year, but it didn't stop our community from supporting the children and families we serve!

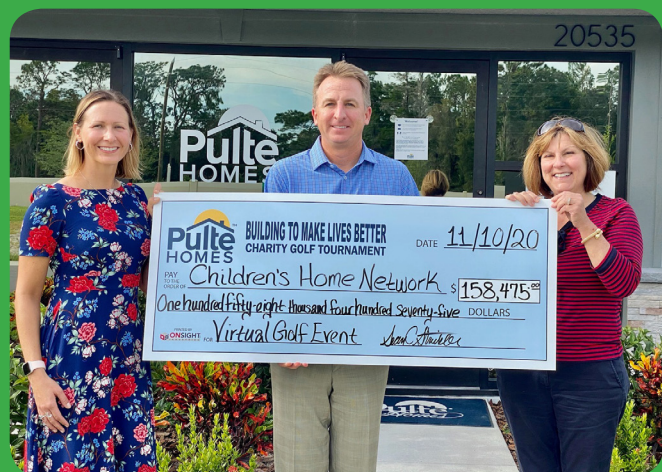

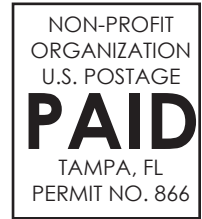
